ENERGY PROGRAM MANAGER – ENERGY FINANCE/ECONOMICS

Join the Maryland Energy Administration (MEA) as we transform energy for the State of Maryland. Through the Strategic Energy Investment Fund and the Maryland Renewable Energy Portfolio Standard (RPS), you will have an opportunity to work on the cutting edge of shaping and implementing Maryland’s clean energy policies. Responsibilities: The Energy Finance/Economics Program Manager is responsible for the development and implementation of energy economic policy and finance programs, including loan, tax credit and bond financing programs, in order to provide affordable, reliable, and clean energy for Maryland. Position provides technical review and support for energy economic issues, review of economic impact of energy legislation and represents the agency on task forces, panels, workgroups, and committees working in the energy finance sector. More specifically, this position will be responsible for the following:

- Lead agency efforts to promote affordable and accessible financing for Maryland’s residents, commercial enterprises, and non-profit organizations
- Develop and manage economic development grants for the Maryland energy sector; monitor and engage with the Maryland energy finance sector
- Coordinate with other State agencies and the Maryland Clean Energy Center on important energy finance and economic issues
- Provide energy advice to the Director and Governor’s staff as needed on the energy economy
- Coordinate and testify on key Public Service Commission cases; draft testimony, policy letters and advice memorandum in support of annual state legislative efforts
- Coordinate with other State agencies, public and private sector companies and industry associations on energy financial and economic issues affecting Maryland and the region

Qualifications: Candidates should have a bachelor’s degree in business finance, energy or environmental field. Candidates should have at least five years of experience working on energy issues related to the items listed in the responsibilities section (above). Strong presentation, writing, and analytical skills are required. Candidates with a master’s degree and direct energy economic experience are preferred.
