Board Policy on
Energy Management
Date

Recognizing that energy efficiency and conservation is in the best interest of the [School District Name], its personnel, students, as well as the community, the Board is directing the school district to develop an Energy Management Plan (EMP) to control energy consumption and costs that may include the adoption of effective energy management practices, and the utilization of energy-efficient products.

The EMP will be developed by the District Energy Manager in conjunction with a District Energy Committee – a small group representing different parts of school administration to meet periodically and direct policy on energy management issues. Members of the Committee shall be appointed by the Superintendent. The chairman shall be named by the Superintendent from his appointees. Non-voting support members may also be named as determined by the Superintendent.

Implementation of the EMP shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent and the District Energy Manager. The District Energy Manager will report on energy management efforts to the board once a year. The District Energy Committee will update the EMP each year as needed.
