



Authorized Applicant Signature Form

FY26 Residential & Commercial Energy Storage Program

The Authorized Applicant Signature Form ("the Form") is available for an applicant to the Maryland Energy Administration ("MEA") FY26 Residential & Commercial Energy Storage Program¹, for the purpose of authorizing a third-party (e.g., an installation contractor or project developer) to submit an application to the Program on their behalf. This form must be completed and signed by the applicant and their authorized third-party, and included in the FY26 Residential & Commercial Energy Storage Program ("the Program") application package submitted to MEA. Failure to include this signed form when a third-party submits the application will result in rejection of the application.

1. <u>Definitions</u>. The following terms are used in the Form and defined as below.

Applicant: An entity, consistent with the definition of "applicant" under COMAR 14.26.02.02, that applies for funding consideration to the Program, and is specifically identified in the signature section at the end of the Form.

Application: A complete and signed application to the Program that includes all required information and supporting documentation defined in the Program's Funding Opportunity Announcement ("FOA").

Authorized Third-Party: A third-party that the Applicant has authorized to submit an application to the FY26 Residential & Commercial Energy Storage Program on their behalf, and is specifically identified in the signature section at the end of the Form.

- 2. Submission of an Application does not guarantee that the Applicant will receive a grant from the Program.
- 3. MEA may require an Applicant to submit personal information which provides proof of the Applicant's identity, property ownership, or any other information as deemed necessary by MEA to verify the validity of the Application.

- 4. An Applicant has the right to inspect, amend, or correct personal records created by MEA containing such information specified in §(3) of this Form.
- 5. MEA, subject to the Public Information Act², does not share personal information with any other entity.
- 6. MEA and its representatives, subject to the Public Information Act, and other applicable laws, will not disclose confidential financial or commercial information or trade secrets. An Applicant should identity information in the Application that contains trade secrets or confidential financial or commercial information.
- 7. If an Applicant fails to provide all information or documentation that MEA deems necessary to process and evaluate the Application in a timely manner, MEA shall notify the Applicant and Authorized Third-Party in writing, including email, of the Application's missing information or documentation.
- 8. It is within MEA's sole discretion to determine if the Application is eligible for funding consideration under the Program.
- 9. The Authorized Third-Party is hereby authorized to submit an Application to the Program on behalf of the Applicant.
- 10. The Authorized Third-Party acknowledges that (1) submitting the Application does not obligate MEA to compensate the Authorized Third-Party in any form, and (2) does not make the Authorized Third-Party an Applicant.
- 11. It is within MEA's sole discretion to determine if the Application is eligible for funding consideration.
- 12. Should MEA award a grant from the Program, the grant will be awarded directly to the Applicant and not the Authorized Third-Party.
- 13. MEA and its contractors make no representation or warranty and assume no liability with respect to quality, safety, performance, or other aspect of any design, system, or appliance installed pursuant to this Application, and expressly disclaim any such representation, warranty, or liability.
