

# FY2024 Decarbonizing Schools Program Area of Interest 3: Solar on Schools

This application form is for the Maryland Energy Administration (MEA) FY2024 Decarbonizing Schools Program, Area of Interest 3 (AOI 3): Solar on Schools. Application forms for all AOIs can be found on the Decarbonizing Schools webpage. This is a competitive AOI that provides Maryland LEAs with the opportunity to request funding to support the installation and planning of solar arrays on existing school roofs and infrastructure. Eligible locations are ones that meet the <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/journal.org/">HB550</a> requirements including being located in a low-income census tract, and/or in an overburdened or disadvantaged community.
