Combined Heat and Power Grant Program





The Maryland Energy Administration (MEA) FY 20 Combined Heat and Power (CHP) Grant Program is designed to further encourage CHP growth in the state. This \$4.2 million first come, first serve program will target eligible commercial, industrial, institutional, and critical infrastructure facilities (including healthcare, wastewater treatment, and essential state and local government facilities).

Note: As part of the PHI/Exelon Merger, \$3.5 million dollars of the \$4.2 million dollar program budget is reserved for projects being implemented in PEPCO and Delmarva Power Territories.

Individual grants range in size from up to \$425/kW to up to \$575/kW, based on the size of the CHP system, with a maximum per project cap of \$500,000, subject to funding availability.
